

We want you to feel safe at home and in the community.


We want you to have at least one loving and consistent relationship that is there to help when you need support.

## 7 Principles for how we work with Children and Young People

We place children's voice and experience at the heart of everything we do.

We work together with children, young people, parents, extended family, health, education, police and other partners to achieve the best outcomes for children and young people.

We communicate regularly and clearly with our children, families and other professionals.

We work together with other professionals to understand the lived experience of children and young people through understanding their context, being curious and using approaches from our practice toolbox.

We focus on strengths and successes alongside worries and risk to develop safe plans.

We work in a confidential way and only share information with those that need to know.

We are all responsible for making sure that children and young people are safe and receive quality support in a timely way.
