Aim

To promote the recognition of children suffering from neglect and explore professional roles and responsibilities in safeguarding children within a multi-agency setting.

Learning Outcomes

By the end of the course participants will:

- Identify various ways children may be neglected and the impact of this
- Recognise children who are suffering, or who are at risk of suffering neglect
- Identify family and environmental factors that may contribute to neglect and risk
- To familiarize participants with Oldham's neglect strategy and tools that can be used when working with neglect
- Clearly identify professional responsibilities within a multi-agency working environment
